Gaga steps up to buy *Reeker* and sequel from CMG

Ed Noeltner's Cinema Management Group (CMG) has closed a two-film deal with Gaga in Japan on Dave Payne's horror titles *Reeker* and *No Man's Land: The Rise Of Reeker*.

Noeltner brokered the deal with Gaga's senior executive vice president Nick Morumo. LMK also acquired Portuguese rights to *Reeker*.

CMG's upcoming animated title *Luis La Chance* has sold to CP Digital in CIS, VC Multimedia in Portugal, Vision Film in Eastern Europe, and Front Row in the Middle East, which also acquired *The People Speak*, *Chemical Wedding*, *Under Still Waters* and *Drug Wars*.

Film Pop in Turkey took *Luis La Chance* along with *The People Speak*, *Under Still Waters*, *Chemical Wedding*, *Drug Wars* and *The Trials Of Darryl Hunt*.

Vision Film also acquired *The People Speak* and *Under Still Waters* for Poland and CCV took Scandinavian rights to *Under Still Waters*.
