Zambezia scores at global box office

EXCLUSIVE: Los Angeles-based Cinema Management Group has announced initial theatrical results from 15 territories for its 3D animation *Adventures In Zambezia*.

The family feature drew more than 75,000 admissions in Poland and generated \$484,000 to beat out Oscar nominees *Wreck-It Ralph* and *Life Of Pi* and rank as the number one animation in release.

Zambezia has amassed more than \$5.5m from CIS territories and more than \$3m in South Korea, while South Africa has produced a little under \$1m and Portugal \$750,000.

"We're thrilled with the numbers we're seeing from abroad, and we believe it's a sign the sky's the limit for a film about birds," said CMG president Edward Noeltner [pictured]. Upcoming releases are set for Mexico, China and Australia.
