Currently in post-production is the action thriller "Gunned Down" starring Craig Fairbrass, James Cosmo, Mem Ferda and Nick Moran. Produced by Impact Entertainment and directed by Mark McQueen "Gunned Down" was recently shot on location in Marbella, Spain and London. "This stylish revenge thriller can be likened to a cross between "Point Blank" and "Heat," says CMG's President, Edward Noeltner. Also recently acquired for Cannes by CMG is the survival thriller "Numb" starring Jamie Bamber, Marie Avgeropoulos, Aleks Paunovic and Stefanie von Pfetten. In Cannes, CMG will also be hosting the World Premiere screening of Rainmaker Entertainment and Blockade Entertainment's US\$ 20million budgeted animated feature "Ratchet & Clank" which has already sold in over 40 territories.
