FilmBuff plans a theatrical release this spring before an exclusive SVoD run.

Further distribution deals are for Germany (Capelight Pictures), France (Family Films), China (HGC Entertainment), Middle East (Front Row), South Korea (Thanks And Love), Philippines (Captive Entertainment) and India (Picture Works). MVP will distribute in Indonesia, Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia, while Captive Entertainment has also acquired international airlines.
